The Emergency Response Team had one major event, and three other projects that were completed this sorority year:

- 1. Purpose of Emergency Response Team:
- Increase awareness about emergency preparedness activities;
- Provide steps for early response and efficient recovery;
- Provide resource support and guidance for sorority members and communities impacted by natural or man-made disasters; and
- Provide effective and immediate communication strategies to facilitate and aid in preparedness and response.

Ages 51-64 – 40.74% - 11 Ages – 64 and over – 33.33% - 9
